## February 14, 1994

On Monday Night, February 14, 1994 the regular meeting of the Middlesex Board of Commissioners reconvened with Mayor Lewis, Commissioners David Jordan, Bascoe Lewis, Jerry Daniel, Isaac Lewis and Naomi Powell present. Mayor Lewis called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m..

The clerk informed the board that Attorney Liz Fairman said she would not serve as the Hearing Officer. Commissioner Daniel moved to appoint Mayor Harvey Lewis to serve as the hearing officer, his motion was seconded by Commissioner Powell and carried unanimously.

The next item of business was to award the contract for the installation of water and sewer lines on US264A to serve IKEX.

Commissioner Jordan moved to excuse Isaac Lewis from voting on the issue due to the fact that Isaac is owner of the company IKEX, Jordan's motion was seconded by Commissioner Bascoe Lewis and carried with Isaac Lewis not voting on the issue.

Commissioner Jerry Daniel moved to award the bid contract to T.A. Loving Company in the amount of \$45,825.00 with the following stipulations, (1) After deducting the amount that Nash County has agreed to pay on the project, the remainder will be shared equally between the Town of Middlesex and IKEX, and (2) the sewer portion will not proceed until the proper permit has been granted approval by the State EPA.

Commissioner Daniel's motion was seconded by Commissioner Jordan and carried with four votes in favor and Commissioner Isaac Lewis not voting on the issue.

The clerk stated that she had discussed the position of Zoning Administrator with Larry Daniel and he stated that he might be interested in taking the position. She asked the board to give some thought to that possibility.

Being no further business neeting adjourned.
