

July 10, 1995

The Middlesex Governing Body met in regular session on July 10, 1995 at 7:30 p.m. in the town hall. Members present were Mayor Harvey Lewis, Commissioners David Jordan, Naomi Powell, Bascoe Lewis, Isaac Lewis and absent was Commissioner Jerry Daniel. Mayor Lewis called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. and the invocation was given by Commissioner Powell.

The Minutes of the previous meeting were accepted in a motion by Commissioner Jordan, seconded by Commissioner Powell and carried unanimously.

The Financial Statements for the previous month were accepted as correct in a motion by Commissioner Jordan and seconded by Commissioner Bascoe Lewis and carried unanimously.

Chief Brock gave a report on the police activities for the previous month stating that the drug violations were on the uprise.

Mr. Gary Mann was present to request to rent the empty building next door to Rhonda's Flea Market to operate an Antique Business. He stated that he was willing to do some of the cosmetic repairs but could not do any of the carpentry required. The board left the meeting hall to view the building and to get some idea of what would be needed to get it in shape for use. Upon returning to the meeting, the clerk was instructed to contact the Nash County Planning Office and get a building inspector to state what would need to be done to bring it up to code.

Commissioner Powell moved to have a special meeting to discuss what could be done as soon as the information could be obtained from the building inspector, her motion was seconded by Commissioner Bascoe Lewis and carried unanimously.

The board reviewed a letter of resignation from the Library Board Member Angeline Morris. Commissioner Jordan moved to accept the resignation, his motion was seconded by Commissioner Powell and carried unanimously.



The clerk presented a bill for \$131.00 from the NC State Highway Patrol Office for damages to Patrolman Mike Whitley's patrol car that were done when he hit a sewer manhole riser ring that Utility Supervisor Wilson had left on the shoulder of the street. Commissioner Bascoe Lewis moved to pay the bill, his motion was seconded by Commissioner Powell and carried unanimously.

Commissioner Isaac Lewis moved to write Mr. Daniel Bissette a letter requesting either an easement or to purchase a 50'x50' piece of land on which the town could locate a lift station for the NC 231 Sewer Project, his motion seconded by Commissioner Jordan and carried unanimously.

Being no further business, Commissioner Powell moved to adjourn at 9:05 p.m..
