

November 17, 1999

The Middlesex Governing Body met in a Special Called Session at 7:30 p.m. on Wednesday Night, November 17, 1999 in the Conference Room of the Town Hall. Members present were Mayor Bobby R. Bisette, Commissioners Fred Hough, Harold Meacombs, Naomi Powell and Isaac Lewis. Commissioner Bascoe Lewis was absent. Mayor Bisette called the meeting to order and stated that there were three items of business for consideration.

The first item of business was to adopt a resolution to apply for FEMA Funds for sewer line rehabilitation. Commissioner Isaac Lewis moved to adopt the resolution and apply for funds in the amount of \$800,000.00, his motion was seconded by Commissioner Hough and carried unanimously.

The clerk stated that the State of North Carolina now required a Water Management Plan before approving new additions to the system, and she had discussed this with Mike Acquesta of Peirson and Whitman and he stated that his firm could do the plan.

Commissioner Isaac Lewis moved to let Peirson & Whitman do the Water Management Plan for the town, his motion was seconded by Commissioner Meacombs and carried unanimously.

Commissioner Hough moved to give full time employees a Christmas Bonus of \$150.00 and part-time help a bonus of \$75.00, his motion was seconded by Commissioner Lewis and carried unanimously.

Being no further business, Commissioner Meacombs moved to adjourn.
