

March 27, 2002

The Middlesex Governing Body met in Special Called Session on March 27, 2002 at 7:30p.m. in the Conference Room of the Town Hall. Members present were Mayor Bobby R. Bissette, Commissioners Harold Meacombs, Fred Hough, Luke Robinson, Larry Daniel and Bascoe Lewis. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the availability of grant/loan fund USDA, formerly known as Farmers Home Administration. Mayor Bissette called the meeting to order and the board reviewed materials from Peirson & Whitman on the estimated cost of the proposed project for rehabilitation of the sewer system.

The projected costs are as follows:

rehabilitate sewer lines	\$750,000
rehabilitate 39 manholes	83,300
engineering design	61,500
administrative, fiscal & legal	3,500
engineering inspections	68,200
contingency	83,500
 Total project	 1,050.000

The clerk informed the board that the town had been awarded a grant in the amount of \$350,000 from the Rural Center and Mr. Thurman Murphy had stated that USDA would give a grant of \$473,000 and loan the town \$228,000 to be paid back at 4.76 % interest on a twenty year repayment plan at approximately 17,000 per year.

Commissioner Hough moved to apply for and accept funding from USDA, his motion was seconded by Commissioner Meacombs and carried unanimously.

Being no further business, Commissioner Daniel moved to adjourn..
