

Middlesex Governing Body Meeting Minutes
October 11, 2021

Mayor Lewis called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. and gave the invocation. Members present were Commissioners Danny Alford, Cherrye Davis, Ann Lewis, and J.W. McClenny. Harold Meacombs was not present. Police Chief Mike Collins & Utilities Supervisor James Liles was present, there were two guest at this meeting.

The September meeting minutes were approved unanimously as presented in a motion by Commissioner Lewis and seconded by Commissioner Davis.

The amended meeting agenda was unanimously approved as presented in a motion by Commissioner Lewis and seconded by Commissioner McClenny. The vote was carried unanimously.

Gloria Vinson, The Town Clerk, reviewed the September financials, which were unanimously approved as presented in a motion by Commissioner Alford and seconded by Commissioner Lewis.

Police chief Mike Collins, wanted to let us know that he had spoken to Mr. Jamel Winstead that was on our calendar at town hall to reserve the 231 park and he will call us to inform us that he will probably change his reservation for the 231 park to the Bailey Middlesex park because it is bigger and has more room.

Commissioner Alford asked Public Works Superintendent James Liles how is the grease problem going and James answered it is OK.

Mayor Lewis reported 3 miscellaneous permits and there are no new house permits inside and outside town limits being issued for the month of September. County is moving forward on the shell building. A lot of interest and a lot of good response. James Liles interviewed a couple of people for the public works department and is still in the process of interviewing. Mayor Lewis stated that this is an ongoing process.

In new business, Mayor Lewis presented a resolution to support Nash County NCDEQ Merger/Regionalization Feasibility Grant Application for board approval. Commissioner Alford made a motion to accept the resolution and Commissioner Davis seconded and the vote was carried.

Police Chief Mike Collins, presented his letter of resignation to the board effective February 1, 2022. Commissioner Lewis accepted the chief's letter of resignation and Commissioner McClenny seconded it and the vote was carried. Mayor Lewis let the board know that he would put together a job description and post the job for that position.

There were one public comment at this time.

With no further business, Commissioner Lewis moved to adjourn. Commissioner McClenny seconded and the vote was unanimous.
