

Middlesex Governing Body Meeting Minutes  
September 13, 2021

Mayor Lewis called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. and gave the invocation. Members present were Commissioners Danny Alford, Cherrye Davis, Ann Lewis, J.W. McClenny and Harold Meacombs. Police Chief Mike Collins & Utilities Supervisor James Liles was present, there were four guest at this meeting.

The August meeting minutes were approved unanimously as presented in a motion by Commissioner Lewis and seconded by Commissioner Davis.

The meeting agenda was unanimously approved as presented in a motion by Commissioner Meacombs and seconded by Commissioner McClenny.

Gloria Vinson, The Town Clerk, reviewed the August financials, which were unanimously approved as presented in a motion by Commissioner Alford and seconded by Commissioner Lewis.

Police Chief Mike Collins, thanked the board for all the support with National Night Out. Part-time Police Officer Grace Kane was sworn in on September 10, 2021 and will be helping so that the guys can start taking some vacation days.

Mayor Lewis reported 2 miscellaneous permits and 3 new house permits inside town limits being issued for the month of August.

Commissioner Lewis asked if Mayor Lewis had heard anymore news about the old Aggies restaurant opening up. He had not heard any new news but there should be an announcement about the Shell Building in the next 30-45 days. Employment could range from 25 to 75 jobs in the range of 50k with benefits.

In old business, we got released for sewer from the City of Raleigh to move forward with the new subdivision for Ashton Woods on 264A West.

In new business, Public works supervisor James Liles discussed several reasons why we need to hire another full-time person. With the new subdivision coming to town in the near future we would need additional help.
