The Middlesex Governing Body met in Special Open Session to discuss the purchase price of a 50' x 50' tract of land located on Selma Road and owned by Bobby Bissette for the purpose of placing a lift station to serve DFB Development and any other development along Selma Road

Mayor Lewis called the meeting to order at 6:25 p.m. Commissioners Harold Meacombs, Luke Robinson, and J.W. McClenny were present. Commissioners Fred Hough and Derek Bissette were absent.

Mayor Lewis advised that Bobby Bissette is willing to sell the 50' x 50' tract on Selma Road for \$10,000 in order for the town to build a pump station. He stated that all board members present at the June 9th meeting were in agreement to purchase the tract, with the exception of Commissioner Derek Bissette who was excused due to a conflict of interest.

Commissioner Robinson moved to purchase the 50' x 50' tract of land from Bobby Bissette for \$10,000 to place a lift station. Commissioner McClenny seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Being no further business, Commissioner Robinson moved to adjourn.
