

Middlesex Governing Body Meeting Minutes
October 13th, 2025

Mayor Lewis called the public hearing to order and gave the invocation.

The hearing is pertaining to going to land on East Wilson Street to David Hinton from South Spruce Street East Rd 150. There will not be a road build on this property. With no further comments at this time Mayor Lewis declared the public hearing closed.

Mayor Lewis called the meeting to order and gave invocation.

Commissioners present were Cherrye Davis, Danny Alford, Barry Cameron and Harold Meacombs. Commissioner Ann Lewis was not present. Corey Freidman from The Wilson Times was also present. There was one guest at this meeting.

The 2 sets of September meeting minutes were approved in a motion by Commissioner Alford and seconded by Commissioner Meacombs. The vote was unanimously approved.

The agenda was approved unanimously in a motion by Commissioner Meacombs and seconded by Commissioner Davis. The vote was unanimous.

The Town Clerk Gloria Vinson, reviewed the September Financials. Commissioner Meacombs made a motion for the clerks to approve and Commissioner Davis seconded it was unanimous.

Police Chief Joe Amos said National Night Out was canceled due to rain with no reschedule date. There will still be a haunted house on October 31st. They will also hold a truck or treat giving away candy for Halloween.

Mayor Lewis stated there was one Ashton Woods permit, 2 permits outside of town, new house permits inside of town, and 2 miscellaneous permits.

In old business, the following projects are still underway Sewer, Water, and the Water tower.

In new business, the East Wilson Street property from South Spruce Street East 150ft will be deeded to David Hinton, he will pay all cost associated with it. He owns the land on both sides of this property and a road will not be built here. Commissioner Meacombs made a motion to approve and Commissioner Alford seconded it. The vote was unanimously approved.

Commissioner Meacombs made a motion to go into closed session and Commissioner Davis seconded it and the vote was unanimous.
