

Middlesex Governing Body Meeting Minutes
November 10th, 2025

Mayor Lewis called the meeting to order and gave invocation. Commissioners present were Cherrye Davis, Danny Alford, Barry Cameron and Harold Meacombs. Commissioner Ann Lewis was not present. There was one guest at this meeting.

The October meeting minutes were approved in a motion by Commissioner Davis and seconded by Commissioner Alford. The vote was unanimously approved.

The meeting agenda was amended to add a,b,c, in new business. A. Budget amendment for \$ 36,000 for purchasing new water meters. B. The Nash County water line project Ashton woods to Brantley Rd. The town has agreed to pay \$163,750. C. Board approval for a resolution to change the speed limit to 25 mile an hour on Hanes Ave from South Pine Street to Jones Street to Claude Lewis Road. The amended agenda was approved unanimously in a motion by Commissioner Alford and seconded by Commissioner Meacombs. The vote was unanimous.

The Town Clerk Gloria Vinson, reviewed the October Financials. Commissioner Meacombs made a motion to approve the clerks report. Commissioner Davis seconded it was unanimous.

Police Chief Joe Amos said trunk or treat went really well. Everyone that went had great things to say about it. They gave out lots of candy and ate lots of candy.

Mayor Lewis stated there was 3 Ashton Woods permits, 1 permit outside of town, 1 new house permits inside of town, and 3 miscellaneous permits.

In old business, the following projects are still underway Sewer, Water, and the Water tower.

In new business, Commissioner Meacombs made the motion to approve a \$36,000 budget amendment for purchasing new water meters. Commissioner Alford seconded it and the vote was unanimous. The Nash County water line project from Ashton Woods to Brantley Road. Town agrees to pay \$163,750. Commissioner Alford made the motion to use \$163,750 from the money we are getting from the registration to help pay for the water line project from Ashton Woods to Brantley Road. Commissioner Davis seconded and it was unanimously approved. Commissioner Meacombs made the motion to approve a resolution to change the speed limit to 25 miles an hour on Hanes Ave from

South Pine Street to Jones Street to Claude Lewis Road. Commissioner Davis seconded and the vote was unanimous.

There was no public comment at this meeting.

With no further business, Commissioner Meacombs made the motion to adjourn and Commissioner Alford seconded and the vote was unanimous.
